

principal, I took Jackpot to school to meet the kids in the classroom that I work in. He loved them and they loved him!! We made it a teaching and learning experience.


LATEST UPDATE:

Jack goes this Thursday the 16th to have the pins surgically removed



from the right leg, and he will travel back home on Friday the 17th. Time will tell but I know the team at WSU is optimistic that they were able to gain him some improvement in that limb. Based on the study, it appears that the most successful and most frequently performed surgical correction for his condition occurred prior to the age of 21 weeks.
